A. Find the missing addends:

- a. $\underline{\quad} + 21 + 53 = 138$
- b. $68 + 37 + 1,000 + \underline{\quad} + 11 = 1,559$
- c. $383 + \underline{\quad} + 1,170 + 2010 = 5976$

B. Find the missing minuend:

- a. $\underline{\quad} - 348 = 1,797$
- b. $\underline{\quad} - 2986 = 5,126$
- c. $\underline{\quad} - 1020 = 4527$

C. Addition and subtraction problems: (don't copy the sums, just write statements and solve)

- a. A milk-dairy produces 25,545 litres of milk every day. It supplies 15,625 litres of milk to a milk-depot and the rest to the market. How much milk is supplied to the market?
- b. The sum of two numbers is 94,506. One of the numbers is 49,605. Find the other number?
- c. There are 63,675 bags of wheat and rice together in the grain stock. The wheat bags are counted as 34,768 in number. Find the number of rice bags?
- d. There are 1,870 students in school A, 2,790 students in school B, and 1,987 students in school C. Find the total number of students in the three schools. Among these students 2,153 students are girls. Find the number of boys?
